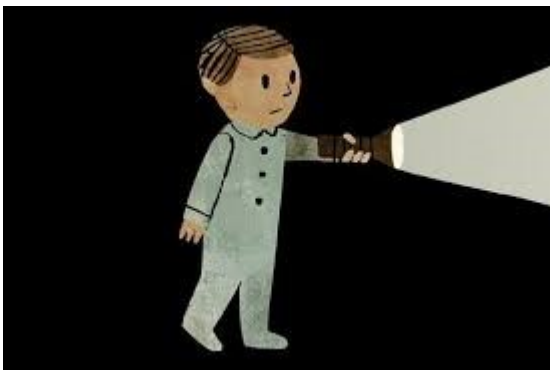
Year 2 Newsletter
