COVID – Although we are continuously striving towards good attendance in school, if your child is displaying any COVID symptoms, i.e. a cough or temperature, please have a PCR test done for them as COVID numbers are on the increase.

Please remember, a lateral flow test is only for use if there are no COVID symptoms.

School Photographs – sibling photos before school from 8.00am. Please come in through the school hall for these and leave through main entrance. Please note, siblings who are in school will have their photographs taken during school time so this session is only if you also have children who do not attend Motcombe.

Your child may wear their own clothes instead of uniform if you would prefer. Please do not send them to school in their PE kit if it is usually their PE day.

Drop off and Pick Up – Please do not let your children play on the field before and after school as the staff spend time clearing and tidying it for the next day.

Pupil Premium - Supermarket Vouchers – You will be aware that the government have been providing funding, since lockdown, for supermarket vouchers for families eligible for Pupil Premium (free school meals). They are continuing to do this up to the end of the Easter holiday next year, as detailed below:-

- two week Christmas holiday £50 per eligible pupil in recognition of the increased costs of providing food over Christmas
- February 2022 half-term £15 per eligible pupil
- two week Easter holiday 2022 £30 per pupil

If you are in receipt of any of the following you may be eligible:

- Universal Credit
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, only if your annual household income (assessed by HM Revenue & Customers) isn't over £16,190

Please note, anyone in receipt of Working Tax Credit will not get free meals regardless of income.

• Working Tax Credit run on – paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.

Please remember that all infant school children are entitled to Universal Free School Meals. Pupil Premium (free school meals) provides additional funding to schools for other things including help with additional learning support for children and help with paying for school trips.

Foundation Stage – Vision & National Child Measurement Programme – The team will be in school on 30 November and 1 December to carry out these checks. Please see email sent earlier this week with further information and details of how to opt out.
